

AN ACT to amend the Laws relating to the Supply of Water to the Town of New Norfolk. [29 September, 1865.]

W HEREAS the Laws relating to the supply of Water to the Town PREAMBLE. of New Norfolk require amendment in certain particulars: Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 The Municipal Council shall once in every year make and levy a Levy of annual Rate upon and from the Occupiers of every house, building, and premises rate. within the Town, according to the class within which the house, building, or premises is comprised, not exceeding the sums named in the following scale:—

Penalty on persons felling trees into or across the Lachlan Rivulet.

4 If any person wilfully cuts or fells, or causes to be cut or felled, any tree or any part thereof, or any timber, so that the same or any part thereof falls or is cast into or across the *Lachlan Rivulet*, or any watercourse leading thereto or therefrom, he shall, on conviction thereof before any Two Justices of the Peace, forfeit and pay for every such offence a penalty not exceeding Fifty Pounds.

Repeal of Sects. 8 and 9 of 24 Vict. No. 17.

5 Sections Eight and Nine of the Act of the Parliament of *Tasmania* of the 24 *Victoria*, No. 17, shall be hereby repealed, but such repeal shall not affect anything duly done thereunder.

Acts to be read together.

6 This Act and the Act of Council of the 4th *Victoria*, No. 4, and the Acts of the Parliament of *Tasmania* of the 24th *Victoria*, No. 17, and of the 27th *Victoria*, No. 36, save as altered by this Act, shall be read and construed together as one and the same Act.
