ANALYSIS.

1. Power to Treasurer to pay £336 out of Revenue

2. Validation of acceptance.

AN ACT to authorise the Payment to, and 1927. Receipt by, the Honourable Albert George Ogilvie and the Honourable Tasman Shields of remuneration in respect of Special Services rendered by them to the State.

[16 September, 1927.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 It shall be lawful for the Treasurer to pay out of the Consolidated Power to Revenue to the Honourable Albert George Ogilvie a sum not exceeding Treasurer to pay One hundred and twenty-six Pounds and to the Honourable Tasman Revenue. Shields a sum not exceeding Two hundred and ten Pounds as remuneration in respect of certain special services rendered to the State by the said Albert George Ogilvie and Tasman Shields in relation to the preparation and presentation of the claim made by this State upon the Government of the Commonwealth.

2 It shall be lawful for the Honourable Albert George Ogilvie and the Honourable Tasman Shields to accept and retain the said sums of One hundred and twenty-six Pounds and Two hundred and ten Pounds respectively, and the provisions of the Constitution Act shall not apply in relation to their acceptance or retention thereof.
