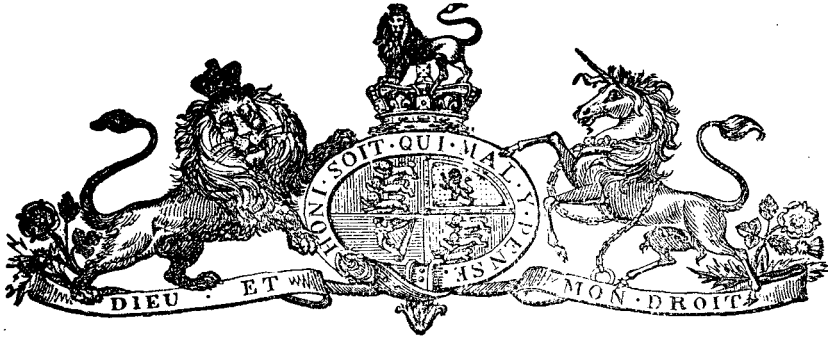

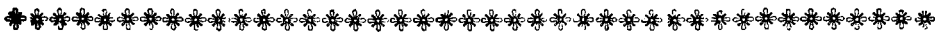

AN ACT to amend "The Railway Construction Act, 1885." [4 February, 1889.] A.D. 1889.

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :—

1 In this Act the expression "The said Act" means "The Railway Construction Act, 1885." Interpretation. 49 Vict. No. 41.

2 Notwithstanding anything to the contrary contained in Section Four of the said Act, it shall be lawful for the Minister of Lands and Works to cause to be executed under the said Act certain improvements and additions to the Line of Railway to be known as the *Green Ponds* Railway, for the purpose of enabling higher speed and weight of trains to be run on the said Railway, at a cost not exceeding Twelve thousand Pounds. Minister to cause certain Works to be executed on *Green Ponds* Railway.

3 Notwithstanding anything to the contrary contained in Section Four of the said Act, it shall be lawful for the Minister of Lands and Works to cause to be executed under the said Act certain improvements and additions to the Line of Railway to be known as the *Chudleigh* Railway, for the purpose of enabling higher speed and weight of trains to be run on the said Railway, at a cost not exceeding Two thousand Pounds. Minister to cause certain Works to be executed on *Chudleigh* Railway.

4 The costs of the said Works mentioned in the Two preceding Sections shall be defrayed out of the moneys to be provided by Parliament for that purpose. Defrayments of cost of Works.

5 This Act and the said Act, save as amended by this Act, shall be read and construed together as one Act. Acts to be read together.
