

N ACT to amend "The Railway Con- A.D. 1889. struction Act, 1885." [4 February, 1889.] AN ACT

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 In this Act the expression "The said Act" means "The Railway Interpretation. Construction Act, 1885."

2 Notwithstanding anything to the contrary contained in Section Minister to cause Four of the said Act, it shall be lawful for the Minister of Lands and certain Works to Works to cause to be executed under the said Act certain improvements be executed on and additions to the Line of Railway to be known as the Green Ponds Railway. Railway, for the purpose of enabling higher speed and weight of trains to be run on the said Railway, at a cost not exceeding Twelve thousand Pounds.

3 Notwithstanding anything to the contrary contained in Section Minister to cause Four of the said Act, it shall be lawful for the Minister of Lands and certain Works to Works to cause to be executed under the said Act certain improvements and additions to the Line of Railway to be known as the Chudleigh Railway. Railway, for the purpose of enabling higher speed and weight of trains to be run on the said Railway, at a cost not exceeding Two thousand Pounds.

4 The costs of the said Works mentioned in the Two preceding Defrayments of Sections shall be defrayed out of the moneys to be provided by Parlia- cost of Works. ment for that purpose.

5 This Act and the said Act, save as amended by this Act, shall be Acts to be read read and construed together as one Act. together.
