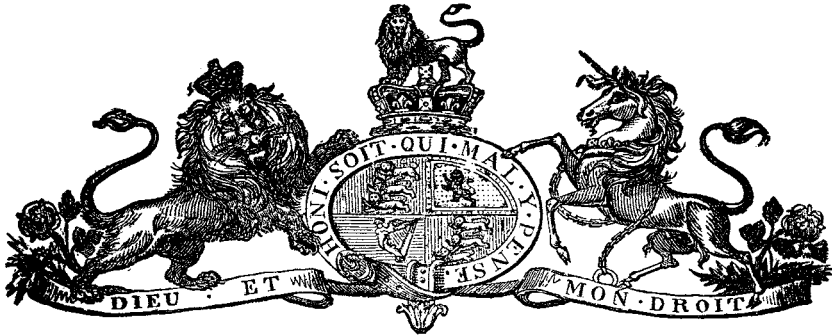

AN ACT to authorise the raising of a Sum not exceeding £25,000 by Debentures.

A.D. 1879.

[5 May, 1879.]

WHEREAS it is expedient to raise a Sum not exceeding £25,000 by Debentures, secured upon "The Consolidated Revenue Fund," for the purposes of this Act:

PREAMBLE.

Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :—

1 It shall be lawful for the Governor to cause to be raised, by the issue and sale of Debentures secured on "The Consolidated Revenue Fund," in like manner as is prescribed in the Act 20 *Victoria*, No. 9, such sum or sums of money, not exceeding in the whole £25,000, as may be required for the purposes of an Act of this present Session of Parliament, intituled "An Act to provide for the Execution of certain Works for the Defence of the Colony of *Tasmania*."

Governor may raise £25,000 by Debentures.

2 All such Debentures shall bear Interest at the rate of Five Pounds per centum per annum, and shall be redeemable in the year 1884.

Interest thereon and period of redemption.

3 All provisions contained in the said Act of the 20th *Victoria*, No. 9, shall apply and extend to the Debentures to be issued in pursuance of this Act.

Provisions of 20 Vict., No. 9, to be applicable.
