

AN ACT to authorise the raising of a Sum not A.D. 1879. exceeding £25,000 by Debentures.

[5 May, 1879.]

WHEREAS it is expedient to raise a Sum not exceeding £25,000 PREAMBLE. by Debentures, secured upon "The Consolidated Revenue Fund," for the purposes of this Act:

Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:

1 It shall be lawful for the Governor to cause to be raised, by the Governor may issue and sale of Debentures secured on "The Consolidated Revenue raise £25,000 by Debentures Fund," in like manner as is prescribed in the Act 20 Victoria, No. 9, such sum or sums of money, not exceeding in the whole £25,000, as may be required for the purposes of an Act of this present Session of Parliament, intituled "An Act to provide for the Execution of certain Works for the Defence of the Colony of Tasmania."

2 All such Debentures shall bear Interest at the rate of Five Pounds Interest thereon per centum per annum, and shall be redeemable in the year 1884.

3 All provisions contained in the said Act of the 20th Victoria, Provisions of No. 9, shall apply and extend to the Debentures to be issued in 20 Vict., No. 9, pursuance of this Act.
