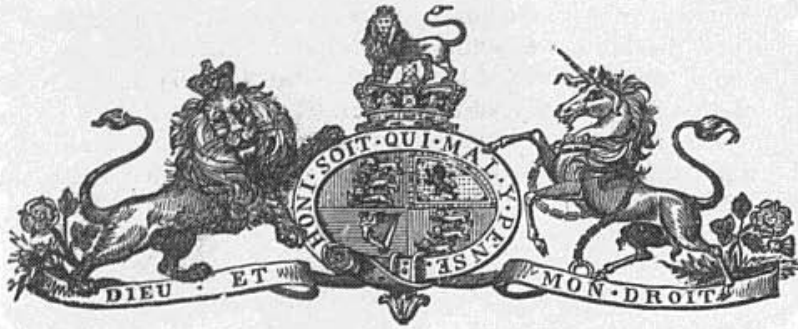

AN ACT to authorise the raising of Loans for
Public Works on the Security of the Conso-
lidated Revenues of the Colony. [5 June, 1857.]

WHEREAS it is expedient to enable the Government to borrow a sum of money, not exceeding in the whole £75,250, for the execution of the permanent Works of public utility and convenience set out in the Schedule hereto: Be it therefore enacted by the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

PREAMBLE.

1 It shall be lawful for the Governor with the advice of the Executive Council, from time to time, to raise by the issue and sale of Debentures secured upon the General Revenue of the Colony, in like manner as is prescribed in the Act of the Parliament of *Tasmania*, 20 *Victoria*, No. 9, and bearing Interest at a rate not exceeding £6 per centum per annum, such sum or sums of money not exceeding £75,250 as may be required for the construction and completion of the several Public Works set out in the Schedule hereto; such Debentures to be redeemable as follows; that is to say—as to the amount of £20,000 in the year 1872; as to the amount of £25,000 in the year 1877; as to the amount of £25,000 in the year 1882; and as to the amount of £5250 in the year 1887.

2 All and every the clauses, provisions, powers, penalties, forfeitures, and disabilities contained in the said Act, 20 *Victoria*, No. 9, shall be applied and extended to the Debentures to be issued in pursuance of this Act, as fully and effectually to all intents and purposes as if the several sections, provisions, powers, penalties, forfeitures, and disabilities had been particularly repeated and re-enacted in the body of this Act.
