

AN ACT to authorise the raising of the Sum of £17,000 by Debentures chargeable on the General Revenue of Tasmania for making good the Supplies for the Public Service in the Year 1865. [15 September, 1865.]

W HEREAS the estimated Revenue of the year 1865 is insufficient PREAMBLE. to meet the ordinary Expenditure required for that year, and the sum of £17,000 is necessary to supply such deficiency; and it is expedient to raise such sum by Loans secured on the General Revenue: Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 Towards making good the Supply granted to Her Majesty for the Government may service of the year 1865, it shall be lawful for the Governor in Council raise £17,000 to cause to be raised a sum not exceeding £17,000 in the whole by the by Debentures. issue and sale of Debentures secured on the General Revenue, in like manner as is prescribed in the Act of the Parliament of Tasmania, 20th Victoria, No. 9, such Debentures to be redeemable as follows; that is to say-

As to the amount of £5000 in the year 1888; As to the amount of £5000 in the year 1889; As to the amount of £7000 in the year 1890.

Debentures, £17,000, General Revenue.

Provisions of 20 Vict. No. 9, to apply to such Debentures.

2 All and every the clauses, provisions, powers, penalties, forfeitures, and disabilities contained in the said recited Act shall be applied and extended to the Debentures to be issued in pursuance of this Act, as fully and effectually to all intents and purposes as if the several clauses, provisions, powers, penalties, forfeitures, and disabilities had been particularly repeated and re-enacted in the body of this Act.
