

AN ACT to authorise the raising of the Sum of £30,500, by Debentures chargeable on the Land Fund of Tasmania, to reimburse the Land Fund for Advances made for the Discharge of a Debt paid to the Imperial Government in the Year 1865. [20 February, 1867.]

W HEREAS the Land Fund for the year 1865 was insufficient to PREAMBLE. meet the extraordinary Expenditure required for that year, and the sum of £30,500 is necessary to supply such deficiency; and it is expedient to raise such sum by Loans secured on the Land Fund: Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 Towards making good the Supply granted to Her Majesty for the Government may service of the year 1865, it shall be lawful for the Governor in Council raise £30,500 by to cause to be raised a sum not exceeding £30,500 in the whole by the issue and sale of Debentures secured on the Land Fund, in like manner as is prescribed in the Act of the Parliament of *Tasmania*, 20th Victoria, No. 9, such Debentures to be redeemable as follows; that is to say—

As to the amount of £20,000 in the year 1871; As to the amount of £5500 in the year 1872. As to the amount of £5000 in the year 1902.

Debentures, £30,500, Land Fund.

Provisions of 20 Vict. No. 9, to apply to such Debentures.

2 All and every the clauses, provisions, powers, penalties, forfeitures, and disabilities contained in the said recited Act shall be applied and extended to the Debentures to be issued in pursuance of this Act, as fully and effectually to all intents and purposes as if the several clauses, provisions, powers, penalties, forfeitures, and disabilities had been particularly repeated and re-enacted in the body of this Act.
