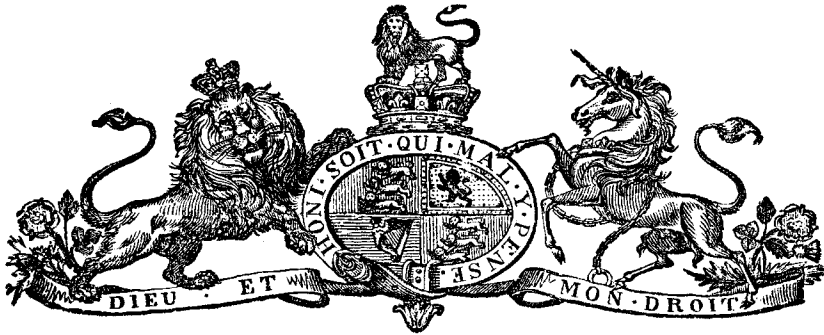

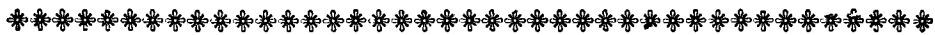

AN ACT to authorise the raising of the Sum of £4000, by Debentures chargeable on the General Revenue of *Tasmania*, for making good the Supplies for the Public Service for the Year 1866. [30 November, 1866.]

WHEREAS the estimated Revenue of the year 1866 is insufficient to meet the ordinary Expenditure required for that year, and the sum of £4000 is necessary to supply such deficiency; and it is expedient to raise such sum by Loans secured on the General Revenue: Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

PREAMBLE.

1 Towards making good the Supply granted to Her Majesty for the service of the year 1866, it shall be lawful for the Governor in Council to cause to be raised a sum not exceeding £4000 in the whole by the issue and sale of Debentures secured on the General Revenue, in like manner as is prescribed in the Act of the Parliament of *Tasmania*, 20th *Victoria*, No. 9; and the Debentures to be issued by virtue of this Act shall be redeemable in the year 1869.

Government may raise £4000 by Debentures.

2 All and every the clauses, provisions, powers, penalties, forfeitures, and disabilities contained in the said recited Act shall be applied and extended to the Debentures to be issued in pursuance of this Act, as fully and effectually to all intents and purposes as if the several clauses, provisions, powers, penalties, forfeitures, and disabilities had been particularly repeated and re-enacted in the body of this Act.

Provisions of 20 Vict. No. 9 to apply to such Debentures.
