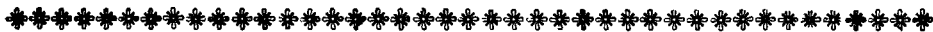

AN ACT to confer further Powers upon A.D. 1888.  
Commissioners of Courts of Requests.  
[8 October, 1888.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :—

**1** The powers conferred upon the Supreme Court by Section Sixty-eight of "The Small Debts Act, 1887," are hereby vested in and may be exercised by the Commissioner of any Court of Requests appointed to be held under the said Act for the recovery of debts and demands not exceeding the sum of Fifty Pounds.

Powers conferred by Sect. 68 of 51 V. No. 23 may be exercised by Commissioners.

**2** The powers conferred by this Act shall be in addition to and not in derogation of the powers now possessed at Law by any such Commissioner as aforesaid.
