AN ACT to declare the Town of *Launceston* a City. A.D. 1888.  
[16 October, 1888.]

**W**HEREAS it is expedient to declare the Town of *Launceston* to be a City :

Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :—

**1** The Town of *Launceston* is hereby declared to be a City ; and, on and after the day on which this Act comes into operation, shall be called, in all Acts of Parliament, deeds, and documents, the City of *Launceston*. Town of *Launceston* to be a City.

**2** The Body Corporate and Politic constituted by *The Launceston Corporation Act*, and known by the name of the Mayor, Aldermen, and Burgesses of the Town of *Launceston*, shall, on and after the day on which this Act comes into operation, be known as the Mayor, Aldermen, and Citizens of the City of *Launceston*. Name of Body Corporate.

**3** Every Act of Parliament and deed and document in which the Town of *Launceston* is mentioned or referred to shall, on and after the day on which this Act comes into operation, be read and construed as if the City of *Launceston* was therein mentioned or referred to in every place in which such Town is mentioned or referred to. Town to be read as City.

**4** Every Act of Parliament and deed and document in which the Mayor of the Town of *Launceston* is mentioned or referred to shall, on and after the day on which this Act comes into operation, be read and construed as if the Mayor of the City of *Launceston* was therein mentioned or referred to in every place in which such Mayor is mentioned or referred to.

Where Aldermen,  
&c. mentioned, to  
be read as Alder-  
men, &c. of City.

**5** Every Act of Parliament and deed and document in which the Mayor and Aldermen or Aldermen or the Municipal Council of the Town of *Launceston* are mentioned or referred to shall, on and after the day on which this Act comes into operation, be read and construed as if the Mayor and Aldermen or Aldermen or the Municipal Council of the City of *Launceston* were therein mentioned or referred to in every place in which such Mayor and Aldermen or Aldermen or Municipal Council are mentioned or referred to.

Where Burgesses  
mentioned, to be  
read as Burgesses  
of City.

**6** Every Act of Parliament and deed and document in which the Burgesses of the Town of *Launceston* are mentioned or referred to shall, on and after the day on which this Act comes into operation, be read and construed as if the Citizens of the City of *Launceston* were therein mentioned or referred to in every place in which such Burgesses are mentioned or referred to.

Date of operation.

**7** This Act shall come into operation and take effect on the First day of *January*, 1889.
