

AN ACT to enable the Corporation of Hobart Town to borrow a further Sum of Money on the Credit of the Municipal Rates for the Purpose of completing the Construction of the [29 September, 1865.] Town Hall.

W HEREAS by the Act of the Parliament of Tasmania of the PREAMBLE. 24 Victoria, No. 26, the Municipal Council of the City of Hobart Town 24 Vict. No. 26. was authorised to borrow, upon the security of any Rates levied or paid under the authority of The Hobart Town Improvement Act, any sums 21 Vict. No. 15. of money not exceeding Ten thousand Pounds for the purposes of the said Act: And whereas it has been found necessary to raise a further sum of Ten thousand Pounds for the purpose of completing the construction of the Town Hall under the said Act: Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:-

1 It shall be lawful for the Municipal Council of the City of Hobart Power to effect a Town to borrow upon the security of any Rates levied or paid under further loan of the authority of The Hobart Town Improvement Act such sum or £10,000. sums of money not exceeding Ten thousand Pounds (over and above the said sum of Ten thousand Pounds under the Act of the Parliament of Tasmania of the 24th Victoria, No. 26) as shall be necessary for the purpose of completing the construction of the Town Hall.

## Town Hall.

Savings Banks loan.

2 It shall be lawful for the Trustees for the time being of any Bank may invest in such for Savings in Tasmania, now established or hereafter to be established, to advance and lend to the said Municipal Council, upon the security aforesaid, any part of the said sum of Ten thousand Pounds which the Council is authorised to borrow under this Act, any thing in the Act of Council of the 12th *Victoria*, No. 1, to the contrary notwithstanding.

Acts to be read together.

3 This Act and the said Act of the Parliament of Tasmania of the 24th Victoria, No. 26, shall be read and construed together as one and the same Act.
