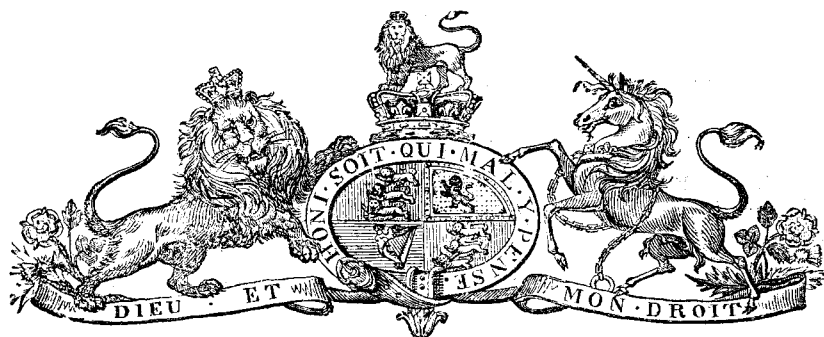

AN ACT to enable the Corporation of *Hobart Town* to build a Town Hall and Public Buildings, to borrow Money on the Credit of the Municipal Rates, and for other Purposes.
[4 October, 1860.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :—

1 It shall be lawful for the Municipal Council of the City of *Hobart Town* to erect and build, upon any land which may be granted to the Corporation of the said City for the purpose, a suitable Town Hall, Town Clerk's Offices, Water Works Offices, Public Library Rooms, and appliances for Public Meetings, and other requisite rooms and places, according to plans and particulars thereof approved by the Director of Public Works, and to his satisfaction, and to repair, maintain, and rebuild the same. Authority to erect Town Hall.

2 It shall be lawful for the said Corporation to purchase or acquire any land suitable for the erection thereon of Public Baths; and for facilitating such purchase or acquisition *The Lands Clauses Act* shall be incorporated herewith; and the Governor is hereby specially authorised Power to buy or acquire Land for Baths.

to grant and alienate to the said Corporation such part of the Queen's Domain as he may think proper for the purpose last aforesaid, for any estate, term, or interest whatsoever.

Power to erect
Baths.

3 It shall be lawful for the said Council to erect on the Land so purchased or acquired suitable and proper Buildings to be used and occupied under such regulations as to them shall seem requisite as and for Public Baths, with all conveniences necessary for the same; and from time to time to maintain, repair, and rebuild all such Public Baths and Buildings, and all roads, ways, and approaches thereto.

Power to borrow
£10,000.

4 It shall be lawful for the Council to borrow any sums not exceeding Ten thousand Pounds upon the security of any Rates levied or paid under the authority of *The Hobart Town Improvement Act*; and if, after having borrowed the said sums or any part thereof, the Council pays off the same, it shall be lawful for the Council again to borrow the amount so paid off, and so from time to time.

Savings Banks
may lend the

5 It shall be lawful for the Trustees or Directors of any Savings Bank in *Tasmania* aforesaid, now or hereafter to be established, to advance to the said Council, on the security aforesaid, the whole or any part of the money hereby authorised to be borrowed; anything in the Act of Council of the 12th *Victoria*, No. 1, or any other Act in relation thereto, notwithstanding.
