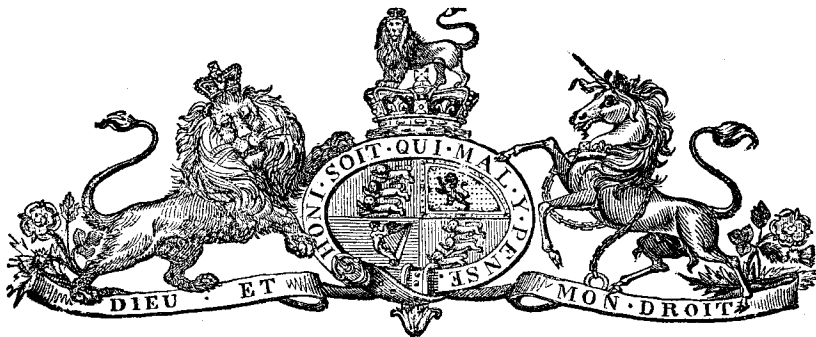

No. 24. Land Fund Act.*

AN ACT to enable the Funds of Savings' Banks
to be invested in Government Debentures.

[22 December, 1857.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, that it shall be lawful for the Managers for the time being of any Savings' Bank, now or hereafter established in *Tasmania*, to advance or lend the Moneys deposited in such Savings' Bank upon the security of any Debentures issued or to be issued by the Government of this Colony, charged upon the Land Fund, in pursuance of any Law now or hereafter passed; anything in the Act of Council of the 12th *Victoria*, No. 1. to the contrary in anywise notwithstanding.
