

AN ACT to enable the Funds of Savings' Banks to be invested in Government Debentures. [22 December, 1857.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, that it shall be lawful for the Savings' Banks Managers for the time being of any Savings' Bank, now or hereafter may invest in established in *Tasmania*, to advance or lend the Moneys deposited in Government Debentures issued or to such Savings' Bank upon the security of any Debentures issued or to be issued by the Government of this Colony, charged upon the Land Fund, in pursuance of any Law now or hereafter passed; anything in the Act of Council of the 12th Victoria, No. 1. to the contrary in anywise notwithstanding.
