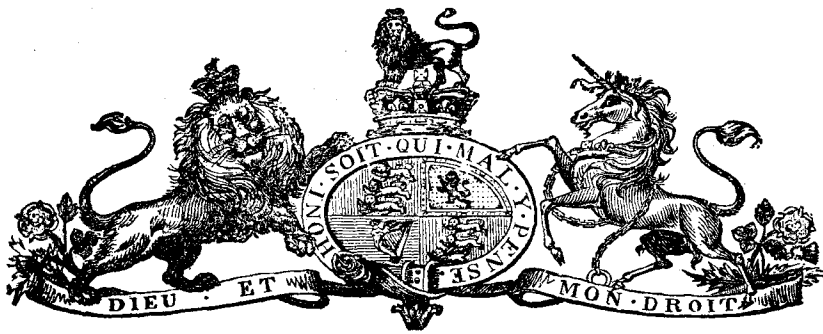

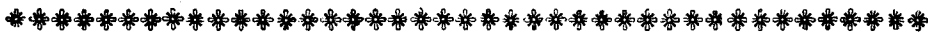

AN ACT to further amend "The Railway Construction Act, 1885." A.D. 1889.

[9 November, 1889.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :—

1 In this Act the expression "The said Act" means "The Railway Construction Act, 1885." Interpretation. 49 Vict. No. 41.

2 Notwithstanding anything to the contrary contained in Section Four of the said Act, it shall be lawful for the Minister to cause to be executed under the said Act certain improvements and additions towards the further completion of the Line of Railway to be known as the *Sorell* Railway, and for the purpose of enabling higher speed and weight of trains to be run on the said Railway, at a cost not exceeding Thirty-seven thousand eight hundred Pounds. Minister to cause certain Works to be executed on Sorell Railway.

3 The costs of the said Works mentioned in the preceding Section shall be defrayed out of the moneys to be provided by Parliament for that purpose. Defrayment of cost of Works.

4 This Act and the said Act, save as amended by this Act, shall be read and construed together as one Act. Acts to be read together.
