

AN ACT to further amend the Law relating A.D. 1896. to General Sessions of the Peace. [2 October, 1896.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 It shall be lawful for the Justices of the Peace assembled at any Justices may elect Court of General Sessions of the Peace to elect, in the manner provided non-resident Jusby Section One of "An Act to amend the Law relating to General Sessions," any Justice of the Peace for the Colony of Tasmania who General Sessions. is a Police or Stipendiary Magistrate, as and to be the Chairman of Such Court of General Sessions for such period as such Justices think proper notwithstending of the Peace to elect, in the manner provided non-resident Justice as Chairman of Court of General Sessions. think proper, notwithstanding anything to the contrary contained in the saidAct.
