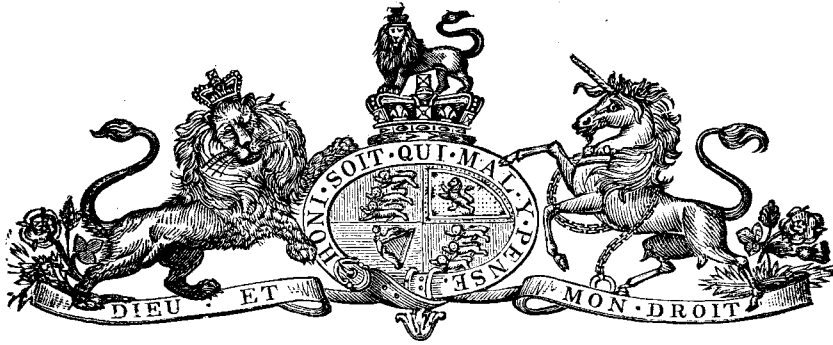

AN ACT to further amend the Law relating A.D. 1896.  
to General Sessions of the Peace.

[2 October, 1896.]

**BE** it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :—

**1** It shall be lawful for the Justices of the Peace assembled at any Court of General Sessions of the Peace to elect, in the manner provided by Section One of "An Act to amend the Law relating to General Sessions," any Justice of the Peace for the Colony of *Tasmania* who is a Police or Stipendiary Magistrate, as and to be the Chairman of such Court of General Sessions for such period as such Justices think proper, notwithstanding anything to the contrary contained in the said Act.

Justices may elect non-resident Justice as Chairman of Court of General Sessions. 21 Vict. No. 10.
