

AN ACT to make provision for the Alienation A.D. 1874. of the Lands of the Crown at Tasman's [18 September, 1874.] Peninsula.

BE it enacted, by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:

1 It shall be lawful for the Governor in Council when he sees fit, by Governor in Proclamation published in the Gazette, to declare that so much of empt part of Tas-Tasman's Peninsula as shall be described in such Proclamation, shall, empt part of Tas-on and after a day to be therein named, be exempt from the operation from of of "The Prison Act, 1868;" and the same shall, on and after such day, 32 Vict. No. 11. be deemed to be "Waste Lands of the Crown," and shall be sold by Public Auction only in the manner and subject to the conditions prescribed by The Waste Lands Act for the sale of Lands by Auction 34 Vict. No. 10. under the said Act.

2 When and so soon as the Prisoners, Lunatics, and Indigent persons Upon removal of now on Tasman's Peninsula shall be removed from the said Peninsula, prisoners, &c., the Governor in Council shall, by Notice published in the Gazette, Gaols to be notify the fact of such removal, and thereupon Sections Thirty-seven to Forty-one, both inclusive, of "The Prison Act, 1868," and the Act of Council of the 9th Victoria, No. 2, shall be repealed; and all buildings and enclosures used on Tasman's Peninsula for the confinement and detention of prisoners shall cease to be Gaols.

Buildings and land disposable as Waste Lands.

34 Vict. No. 10.

3 On and after the date of the Notice mentioned in the last preceding Section, the residue of Tasman's Peninsula not contained in such first-mentioned Proclamation shall be deemed to be "Waste Lands of the Crown," and the same and all buildings and erections thereon shall be disposable under The Waste Lands Act by Public Auction only, in the manner and subject to the conditions contained in the said Act for the sale of Lands by Auction.
