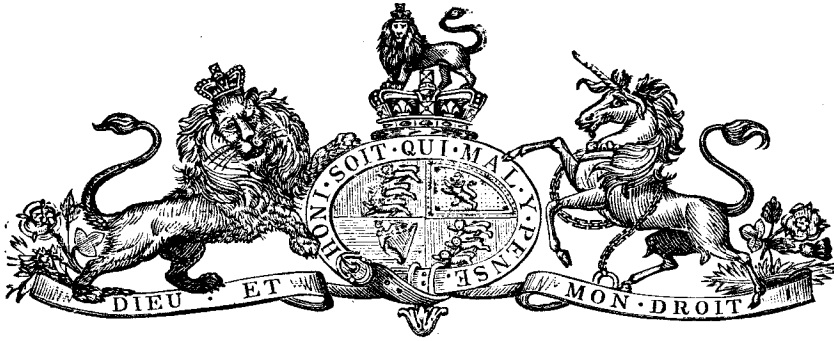

AN ACT to provide for an Increase in the amount of Pension payable to *Lawrence M'Inerney*. A.D. 1896.
[23 October, 1896.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 Notwithstanding anything to the contrary, it shall be lawful for the Treasurer to pay, by way of pension, in the year One thousand eight hundred and ninety-six and every succeeding year, to *Lawrence M'Inerney*, late Attendant and Messenger, Hospital for Insane, *New Norfolk*, the sum of Eleven Pounds Thirteen Shillings and Two Pence; and such sum shall be in addition to and not in diminution of any Superannuation Allowance granted in accordance with the provisions of *The Superannuation Act* to the said *Lawrence M'Inerney*.
