AN ACT to provide for the Payment of a Pension to Mrs. *Louisa Ann Meredith*. [20 October, 1884.]

A.D. 1884.

WHEREAS *Louisa Ann Meredith*, Widow of The Honorable *Charles Meredith*, deceased, has by her writings and paintings rendered considerable services to the cause of Science, Literature, and Art in *Tasmania* :

PREAMBLE.

And whereas it is desirable that the Parliament of *Tasmania* should mark its appreciation of the services so rendered by the said *Louisa Ann Meredith* :

Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :—

1 There shall be payable out of "The Consolidated Revenue Fund" to *Louisa Ann Meredith*, of *Orford*, in *Tasmania*, Widow of The Honorable *Charles Meredith*, deceased, an annual Pension of One hundred Pounds during her life; and such Pension shall be payable and paid quarterly, commencing from the First day of *September*, 1884.

Annual Pension of £100 payable to Mrs. *Louisa Ann Meredith*.

2 The Governor shall, from time to time, issue his Warrant to the Treasurer for the payment of the said Pension, and the same shall thereupon be paid by the said Treasurer to the said *Louisa Ann Meredith*, or to such person as she from time to time, by writing under her hand, appoints to receive the same.

Treasurer to pay Pension upon Warrant of the Governor.

3 It shall be lawful for the Governor, by Warrant under his hand, in case of the death of the said *Louisa Ann Meredith* during the currency of any quarter of a year, to direct payment to be made to her personal representative of a proportionate part of such pension up to the day of her death.

In case of death, payment of proportionate part of Pension to personal representative.
