

AN ACT to provide for the Payment of a A.D. 1884. Pension to Mrs. Louisa Ann Meredith. [20 October, 1884.]

W HEREAS Louisa Ann Meredith, Widow of The Honorable PREAMBLE. Charles Meredith, deceased, has by her writings and paintings rendered considerable services to the cause of Science, Literature, and Art in

And whereas it is desirable that the Parliament of Tasmania should mark its appreciation of the services so rendered by the said Louisa Ann Meredith:

Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 There shall be payable out of "The Consolidated Revenue Fund" Annual Pension to Louisa Ann Meredith, of Orford, in Tasmania, Widow of The of £100 payable Honorable Charles Meredith, deceased, an annual Pension of One to Mrs. Louisa Ann Meredith. and paid quarterly, commencing from the First day of September, 1884.

2 The Governor shall, from time to time, issue his Warrant to the Treasurer to pay Treasurer for the payment of the said Pension, and the same shall Pension upon thereupon be paid by the said Treasurer to the said Louisa Ann Warrant of the Meredith, or to such person as she from time to time, by writing under her hand, appoints to receive the same.

3 It shall be lawful for the Governor, by Warrant under his hand, In case of death, in case of the death of the said Louisa Ann Meredith during the payment of procurrency of any quarter of a year, to direct payment to be made to her personal representative of a proportionate part of such pension up to the sonal represenday of her death.
