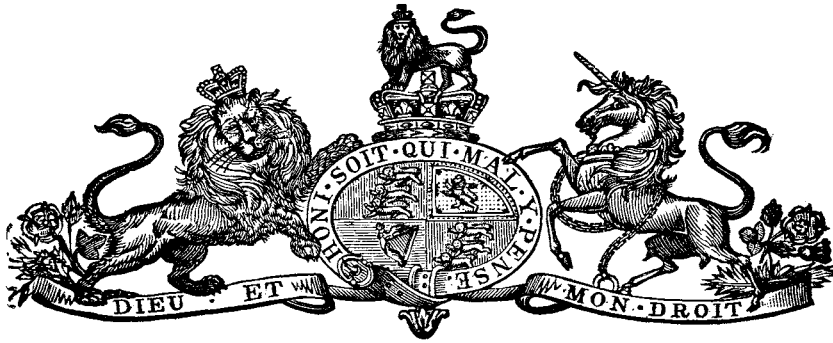

AN ACT to provide for the Payment of Grants A.D. 1888.
for the Encouragement of Deep Sinking for
Minerals. [16 October, 1888.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 It shall be lawful for the Treasurer, for the encouragement of Deep Sinking for Minerals, out of moneys to be provided by Parliament for that purpose, to advance and pay to any person or company any sum or sums of money not exceeding in the whole the sum of Five thousand Pounds (£5000): Provided, that any moneys to be paid under this provision shall be payable only in the proportion of One Pound for every Pound expended by any such person or company in such Deep Sinking for Minerals, and on condition that the locality of the operations shall have been first approved by or on behalf of the Government: Provided further, that all moneys expended hereunder shall be so expended in accordance with Regulations made and approved by the Governor in Council under the Act of Parliament 49 *Victoria*, No. 51. Grant in aid of Deep Sinking.
