*By His Excellency SIR JOHN EARDLEY EARDLEY-WILMOT,
Baronet, Lieutenant-Governor of the Island of Van Diemen's
Land and its Dependencies.*

*AN ACT to provide for the Payment of the Salary of
the Lieutenant-Governor of Van Diemen's Land.*

WHEREAS an Act was passed in the Fourth Year of the Reign of His late Majesty King William the Fourth intituled *An Act to provide for the Payment of the Salaries of the Lieutenant-Governor of Van Diemen's Land and the Judges of the Supreme Court thereof out of the Revenues of the Customs of the said Colony*—AND WHEREAS since the passing of the said Act the Right Honourable the Secretary of State has signified his approval of the Salary of the Lieutenant-Governor being fixed at the increased rate of Three thousand five hundred pounds per annum—AND WHEREAS it is expedient to repeal so much of the said recited Act as relates to the payment to the said Lieutenant-Governor of the Salary therein mentioned and to make provision for the payment of such increased Salary in the manner hereinafter mentioned—**BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED** by His Excellency SIR JOHN EARDLEY EARDLEY-WILMOT Baronet Lieutenant-Governor of the Island of Van Diemen's Land and its Dependencies by and with the advice of the Legislative Council that from and after the passing of this Act so much of the said recited Act as relates to the payment of the Salary of the said Lieutenant-Governor shall be and the same is hereby repealed.

PREAMBLE.

So much of the 4th Wm. 4th No. 5 as relates to the Lieutenant-Governor's Salary repealed.

II. AND BE IT ENACTED that the Treasurer of this Colony shall and may pay to the Lieutenant-Governor of the Island of Van Diemen's Land and its Dependencies aforesaid for the time being the sum of Three thousand five hundred Pounds upon such days times and

£3500 per annum to be paid by the Treasurer to the Lieutenant-Governor and

charged upon the Customs Revenue. periods in each and every year as the Lieutenant-Governor for the time being by any warrant or order in writing under his hand shall from time to time order and direct and that the payments so to be made shall be charged upon and payable out of the Revenues received from the Customs payable in this Colony.

When to be computed from. III. AND BE IT ENACTED that the said Salary or yearly sum of Three thousand five hundred Pounds shall be computed and paid from the twenty-first day of August one thousand eight hundred and forty-three inclusive.

Authority to the Treasurer for making such payments. IV. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that the said Treasurer shall in his Accounts from time to time be allowed credit for any sum or sums so paid by him to the Lieutenant-Governor not exceeding for any one year the sum hereinbefore mentioned and that the receipt or receipts of such Lieutenant-Governor shall be a full and valid discharge to the said Treasurer in passing his said Accounts for any such sum or sums of money as shall be therein mentioned and that he shall receive credit for the same accordingly.
