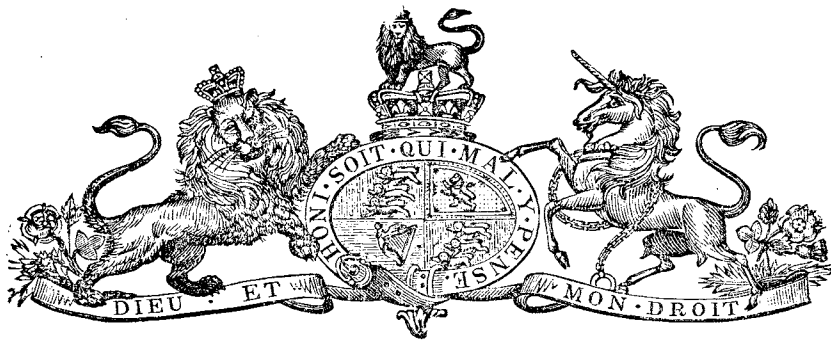

AN ACT to vest in the Board of the Town A.D. 1892.
of *Ulverstone* the Property, Rights, and
Liabilities of the Trustees of the *East*
Ulverstone Recreation Ground.

[21 *December*, 1892.]

WHEREAS the Trustees of the *East Ulverstone* Recreation Ground PREAMBLE.
are desirous to transfer and assign to the Board of the Town of *Ulver-*
stone the land described in the Schedule hereto, and all property,
rights, and liabilities vested in them as Trustees as aforesaid :

And whereas the said Board are willing that such transfer should be
made to them as aforesaid :

Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*,
by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and
House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :—

1 The land described in the Schedule hereto, and all personal Property vested
property, and all moneys, rights, and liabilities of whatsoever in Board.
kind which shall be, on the Thirty-first day of *December*, One
thousand eight hundred and ninety-two, vested in or belonging
to or owing by the Trustees of the *East Ulverstone* Recreation
Ground, shall be and are hereby vested in the Board of the Town
of *Ulverstone* ; and the said Board shall discharge and pay out of
moneys at their disposal under “The Town Boards Act, 1891,” all

liabilities due by the said Trustees on the said Thirty-first day of *December*, One thousand eight hundred and ninety-two.

Upon such land, property, moneys, rights, and liabilities vesting in the Board as aforesaid the said Trustees shall thereupon be freed and discharged from all actions, suits, claims, and demands whatsoever in respect of any act, matter, or thing lawfully done, or suffered to be done by them whilst acting as such Trustees as aforesaid.

SCHEDULE.

TOWN OF ULVERSTONE.

12A. 2R. 0P. or thereabouts.

Bounded on the east by eleven chains and sixty-eight links southerly along Fulton-street commencing at the angle thereof with the Esplanade on Bass Strait, on the south by ten chains and one link westerly along Water-street, on the west by thirteen chains and forty links northerly along Badger-street, and thence on the north east by ten chains and eighteen links or thereabouts south-easterly along the Esplanade aforesaid to the point of commencement.
