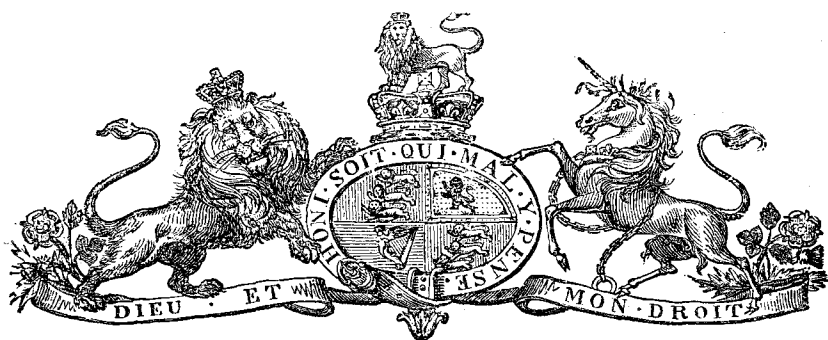

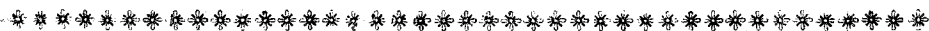

AN ACT to validate the Electoral Roll used at the Election of a Member of the House of Assembly for the Electoral District of *Campbell Town* held on the Twenty-second day of *May*, in the year One thousand eight hundred and ninety-one.

WHEREAS doubts have arisen as to the validity of the Electoral Roll used at the election of a Member of the House of Assembly for the Electoral District of *Campbell Town* held on the Twenty-second day of *May* last past:

PREAMBLE.

And whereas it is desirable that such doubts should be dispelled, and the Roll so used as aforesaid be declared valid:

Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 The Electoral Roll which was used for the election of a Member of the House of Assembly for the Electoral District of *Campbell Town* at the election held on the Twenty-second day of *May*, One thousand eight hundred and ninety-one, is hereby declared to be the Electoral Roll for such District for the year commencing the Eleventh day of *April*, One thousand eight hundred and ninety-one, and ending on the Tenth day of *April*, One thousand eight hundred and ninety-two, and to have been the Electoral Roll for such District on the day of such election as aforesaid.
