AN ACT to validate the Electoral Roll used A.D. 1891. at the Election of a Member of the House of Assembly for the Electoral District of Campbell Town held on the Twenty-second day of May, in the year One thousand eight hundred and ninety-one.

[17 November, 1891.]

W HEREAS doubts have arisen as to the validity of the Electoral PREAMBLE. Roll used at the election of a Member of the House of Assembly for the Electoral District of Campbell Town held on the Twenty-second day of May last past:

And whereas it is desirable that such doubts should be dispelled, and the Roll so used as aforesaid be declared valid :

Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :--

1 The Electoral Roll which was used for the election of a Member Electoral Roll for of the House of Assembly for the Electoral District of Campbell Town Campbell Town at the election held on the Twenty-second day of May, One thousand validated. eight hundred and ninety-one, is hereby declared to be the Electoral Roll for such District for the year commencing the Eleventh day of April, One thousand eight hundred and ninety-one, and ending on the Tenth day of April, One thousand eight hundred and ninety-two, and to have been the Electoral Roll for such District on the day of such election as aforesaid.
