

APPROPRIATION (WHEAT FREIGHT).

No. 32 of 1949.

AN ACT to appropriate and apply a sum from the Consolidated Revenue Fund to the service of the year ending on the thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and fifty.

[1 November, 1949.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 This Act may be cited as the Appropriation (Wheat Freight) Act 1949. Short title.

2 The Treasurer may issue out of the Consolidated Revenue, and apply towards making good the supply hereby granted to His Majesty for the service of the year ending on the thirtieth day of June, 1950, the sum of one hundred and thirty thousand pounds. Issue and application of £130,000.

3 The sum granted by this Act is appropriated for the purposes expressed in the schedule. Appropriation of supplies.

4 The Treasurer may apply any sums of money, not exceeding in the whole the sum set forth in the schedule, for the purposes therein expressed. Power to Treasurer to apply moneys.
