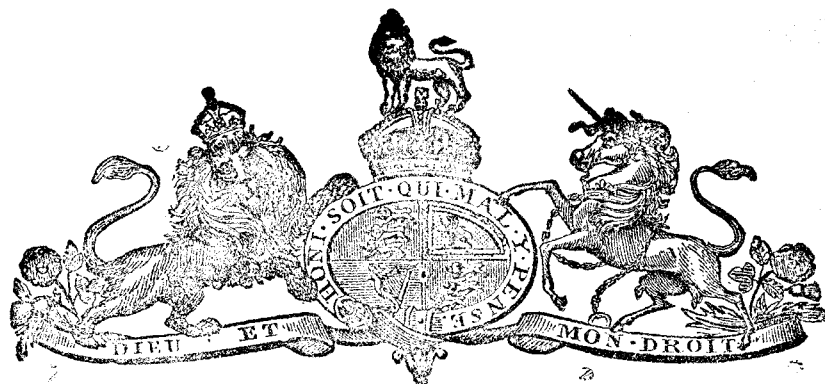

I. By inserting after subsection (3) of section twenty-nine thereof the following new subsection (4):—

“(4) Where the last day of any such period prescribed or allowed for the filing or registration of any document or instrument falls on a day on which the office in which such filing or registration is to be effected is not open, the same may be filed or registered on the next ensuing day on which such office is open.”

47.II. By inserting at the end of paragraph IV. of subsection (1) of section forty-seven thereof the words “and a daily penalty not exceeding two pounds or such greater amount, if any, as may be specified in such **Act.**”
