### ANALYSIS

1. Short title and citation.

**AN ACT to amend the Adoption of Children Act 1968.**

[15 May 1975]

**BE** it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

**1**—(1) This Act may be cited as the *Adoption of Children Act* Short title and citation. 1975.

(2) The *Adoption of Children Act* 1968, as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

**2** Section 21 (2) of the Principal Act is amended by omitting paragraph (a) and substituting therefor the following paragraph:—

“(a) if the father and mother of the child were married to each other at the time of the conception of the child or have since been married to each other, every person who is a parent or guardian of the child; and”.
