 AN ACT to amend the *Burnie Abattoir Act 1932*.
 [21 December, 1939.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania,
 by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative
 Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as
 follows:—

- 1** This Act may be cited as the *Burnie Abattoir Act 1939*. Short title.
- 2** The Principal Act is hereby amended—
 - I. As to section two thereof—
 - (a) By inserting the word “first” before the
 word “schedule” in the definition of
 “The abattoir”: and

(b) By deleting the words from “and includes the Burnie Water Area” to the end of the definition of “Limits of this Act” and substituting therefor the words “the area defined in the second schedule and such other additional or substituted areas as the Governor by proclamation may declare to be included therein”:

Section 15.

II. As to section fifteen thereof by inserting—

(a) “(1)” at the commencement: and
 (b) “(2) An inspector may seize any such carcase for production as evidence in any proceedings under this section and the inspector shall not be liable for any loss or deterioration in value of such carcase resulting from such seizure:

(3) Upon production of such carcase as evidence, the Court may order that the same be—

I. Forfeited to the use of His Majesty, and any proceeds arising therefrom shall be paid into the Consolidated Revenue:

II. Destroyed: or

III. Returned to the person from whom it was seized.” (at the end): and

III. By adding after the first schedule the following new second schedule:—

“THE SECOND SCHEDULE.

Commencing at the eastern side of the Cam River Bridge on the State Highway Burnie to Somerset thence easterly along that highway to the Cam-road East thence along the eastern side of that road to its junction with the West Mooreville-road thence southerly along that road to its junction with the Three-Mile line thence on the south by an easterly line along that road to its junction with the State Highway Burnie to Ridgley thence continuing easterly in a straight line to Chasm Creek thence on the east in a general northerly direction by Chasm Creek to Bass Strait and thence on the north in a general westerly direction by Bass Strait to the eastern side of Cam River thence southerly to the point of commencement.”.
