BIOLOGICAL CONTROL AMENDMENT ACT 1996

No. 10 of 1996

An Act to amend the *Biological Control Act 1986*

[Royal Assent 10 July 1996]

Be it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:

Short title

1. This Act may be cited as the *Biological Control Amendment Act 1996*.

Commencement

2. This Act commences on the day after the day on which it receives the Royal Assent.

Principal Act

3. In this Act, the *Biological Control Act 1986** is referred to as the Principal Act.

Section 3 amended (Interpretation)

4. Section 3(1) of the Principal Act is amended by omitting the definition of "Council" and substituting the following definition:

"Council" means the body known as the Agriculture and Resource Management Council of Australia and New Zealand, whether known by that name or any other name;
