AN ACT to amend the *Bank Holidays Act 1919*.

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1—(1) This Act may be cited as the *Bank Holidays Act 1944*. Short title and citation.

(2) The *Bank Holidays Act 1919*,* as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

2 The Principal Act is amended by adding at the end of subsection (1) of section four thereof the following paragraph— Bank holidays

“VII. The first Monday in March which shall be known as Eight Hours Day.”
