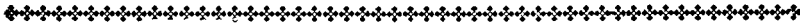

AN ACT to amend the *Bank Holidays Act 1919*.

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 This Act may be cited as the *Bank Holidays Act 1945*. Short title.

2 Every bank and branch of a bank carrying on business in the city of Hobart and the municipality of Glenorchy shall be closed throughout the whole of every Saturday, and every such day shall be deemed to be a bank holiday in that city and municipality: Provided that a reference to a public or bank holiday in any wages board determination or industrial agreement or in any agreement relating to work, whether made before or after the commencement of this Act, shall not be deemed to be a reference to a day on which banks are required to be closed under this section and not otherwise.
