BANK HOLIDAYS.

No. 44 of 1953.

AN ACT to amend the Bank Holidays Act 1919, and to repeal the Bank Holidays Act 1945 and the Bank Holidays Act 1951.

[10 November, 1953.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

- 1—(1) This Act may be cited as the Bank Holidays Act Short title and citation.
- (2) The Bank Holidays Act 1919, as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.
- 2 The Acts that are specified in the schedule to this Act are Repeal repealed.
- 3 Section four of the Principal Act is amended by adding Bank holidays. at the end of subsection (1) the following paragraph:—
 - "IX. Saturday: Provided that a reference to a public or bank holiday in any wages board determination or any industrial agreement or any agreement relating to work, whether made before or after the commencement of this paragraph, shall not be deemed to be a reference to a day on which banks are required to be closed under this paragraph and not otherwise.".
