

BANK HOLIDAYS (No. 2).

No. 45 of 1953.

AN ACT to amend the *Bank Holidays Act 1919*.

[10 November, 1953.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

Short title
and citation.

1—(1) This Act may be cited as the *Bank Holidays Act (No. 2) 1953*.

(2) The *Bank Holidays Act 1919*, as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

2 Section four of the Principal Act is amended by omitting paragraph III. of subsection (1) and substituting therefor the following paragraph:—

“ III. Christmas Day and Boxing Day: Provided that—

(a) When Christmas Day falls on a Friday the following Monday shall also be a bank holiday and, for the purposes of section eleven, Boxing Day shall be deemed to be publicly observed on that Monday and not on the preceding Saturday: and

(b) When Christmas Day falls on a Saturday or Sunday the following Monday and Tuesday shall be bank holidays and shall, for the purposes of section eleven, be deemed to be the days on which Christmas Day and Boxing Day respectively are publicly observed.”
