



## BANK HOLIDAYS AMENDMENT ACT 1989

**AN ACT to amend the Bank Holidays Act 1919 and for related purposes.**

**[Royal Assent 18 April 1989]**

**B**E it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

**1**—This Act may be cited as the *Bank Holidays Amendment Act 1989*. Short title.

**2**—This Act shall commence on the day on which it receives the Royal assent. Commencement.

Principal Act.

**3**—In this Act, the *Bank Holidays Act 1919*\* is referred to as the Principal Act.

Amendment of section 4 of Principal Act (Bank holidays).

**4**—Section 4 of the Principal Act is amended as follows:—

(a) by omitting paragraph (e) of subsection (1);

(b) by omitting from paragraph (h) of subsection (1), and from subsection (2), “His Majesty” and substituting “the Sovereign”.

Regatta Day holiday to be taken to have replaced Recreation Day holiday in certain places.

**5**—For the avoidance of doubt, it is hereby declared that, where, before the commencement of this Act, a special day was appointed under section 8 of the Principal Act to be observed as a bank holiday in any part of Tasmania, or in any city, town, or district, in relation to holding, in any year, of the regatta known successively as the Hobart Regatta and the Royal Hobart Regatta, the first Monday in November in that year was not, and shall not, for any purpose, be taken to have been, a bank holiday in that part, or that city, town, or district.
