AN ACT to amend the Emergency Housing Accommodation Act 1946. [22 April, 1952.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

Short title and citation.

- 1—(1) This Act may be cited as the *Emergency Housing* Accommodation Act 1952.
- (2) The Emergency Housing Accommodation Act 1946, as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.
- 2 The Principal Act, as continued by the Expiring Laws Continuance Act 1950, and the Expiring Laws Continuance Act (No. 2) 1951, is amended by repealing section ten thereof and substituting therefor the following section:—

"10. This Act shall expire on the thirtieth day of June, 1953.".

AN ACT to amend the Forestry Act 1920. [22 April, 1952.]

1—(1) This Act may be cited as the Forestry Act 1952. Short title

(2) The Forestry Act 1920, as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

 - (a) by omitting subsection (1) thereof and substitut-land. ing therefor the following subsection:-
 - "(1) The Minister, on the recommendation of the Commission, may, subject to the consent of Parliament, purchase any land which is required for any of the purposes of this Act.";

(b) by omitting from subsection (2) thereof the words

"or acquiring";

(c) by inserting in the proviso to subsection (2) thereof, before the word "Commission", the words "Minister may, on the recommendation of the", and by omitting from that proviso the words "or acquire " and the words " or acquisition", respectively:

(d) by omitting from subsection (3) thereof the words "or acquired" (twice occurring);

(e) by omitting from subsection (4) thereof all the words after the word "may" to the end of that subsection and substituting therefor the words ", if the Commission so recommends, be sold by the Minister as he may think fit"; and
