### **AN ACT to amend the Builders Registration Act 1977.**

[20 December 1978]

**BE** it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

**1—**(1) This Act may be cited as the *Builders Registration Act* Short title and citation. 1978.

(2) The *Builders Registration Act 1977*\* is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

**2** Section 3 of the Principal Act is amended—

(a) by omitting subsection (2) and substituting the following subsection:—

(2) The Board shall consist of a chairman and 7 other members appointed by the Governor, and one of such members shall be a member of the Master Builders Association of Northern Tasmania; and

(b) by omitting from subsection (3) the whole of paragraph (a) and substituting the following:—

“(a) three being appointed as representative of building contractors of whom two shall be representative of building contractors holding full registration and one shall be representative of building contractors holding limited registration;”.

**3**—Section 4 of the Principal Act is amended by omitting from subsection (3) the word “Four” and substituting the numeral “5”.
