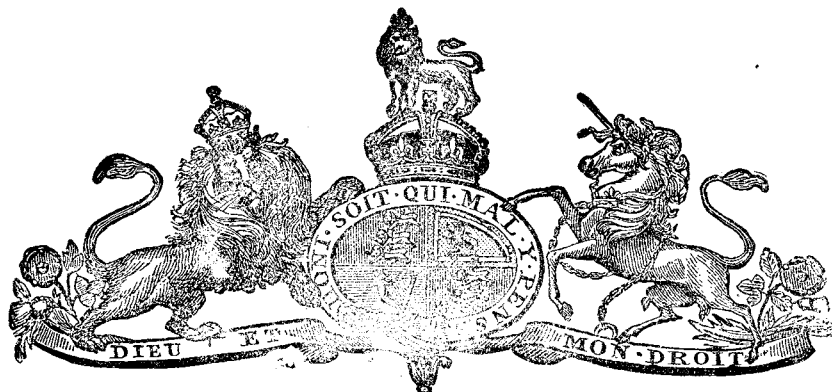

AN ACT to amend the *Cemeteries Act 1865*.

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :—

1 This Act may be cited as the *Cemeteries Act 1935*.

Short title.

2 The *Cemeteries Act 1872* is hereby amended by substituting for repealed section seven thereof the following new section seven—

“**7**—(1) The trustees of any cemetery, with the consent of the Governor, may grant a lease of any portion of the land vested in them for the purpose of the erection and maintenance thereon of a crematory in accordance with the *Cremation Act 1934*.
