## CONSTITUTION.

No. 27 of 1949 .

## AN ACT to amend the Constitution Act 1934. [5 October, 1949]

$\mathrm{B}^{\mathrm{E}}$ it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:-

Short title and citation.

1-(1) This Act may be cited as the Constitution Act 1949.
(2) The Constitution Act 1934*, as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

## AN ACT to amend the Auction Act 1913. [5 October, 1949.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:-

2 Section twelve of the Principal Act is amended by omitting the word " and ", after paragraph I., and by inserting after that paragraph the following paragraph:-
" IA. Any auction sale of wool may take place between the hours of six o'clock in the morning and halfpast ten o'clock in the evening of the same day: and ".
