AN ACT to amend the Criminal Code.

[1 May 1974]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

- 1—(1) This Act may be cited as the Criminal Code Act 1974. Short title and citation.
- (2) The Criminal Code is in this Act referred to as the Code.

Defilement of girls under eighteen.

- **2** Section one hundred and twenty-four of the Code is amended—
- (a) by omitting from subsection (1) the word "eighteen" (wherever occurring) and substituting therefor, in each case, the word "seventeen";
- (b) by omitting from subsection (2) the word "twenty-one" and substituting therefor the word "eighteen";
- (c) by omitting from that subsection the word "eighteen" and substituting therefor the word "seventeen"; and
- (d) by omitting from subsection (3) the word "sixteen" and substituting therefor the word "fifteen".

Person permitting defilement of young girls on his premises. **3** Section one hundred and twenty-five of the Code is amended by omitting the word "eighteen" and substituting therefor the word "seventeen".

Indecent assault.

- 4 Section one hundred and twenty-seven of the Code is amended—
 - (a) by omitting from subsection (3) the word "eighteen" and substituting therefor the word "seventeen"; and
 - (b) by omitting from that subsection all the words occurring after the word "section".

Procuration.

5 Section one hundred and twenty-eight of the Code is amended by omitting from paragraph (a) the word "unlawful".

Encouraging seduction.

6 Section one hundred and thirty-two of the Code is amended by omitting from subsection (1) the word "eighteen" (wherever occurring) and substituting therefor, in each case, the word "seventeen".

Abduction from motives of lucre. **7** Section one hundred and eighty-seven of the Code is amended by omitting from subsection (2) the word "twenty-one" (where-ever occurring) and substituting therefor, in each case, the word "eighteen".

Abduction of young girl with intent to defile.

- **8** Section one hundred and eighty-eight of the Code is amended—
 - (a) by omitting from subsection (1) the word "eighteen" (wherever occurring) and substituting therefor, in each case, the word "seventeen";
 - (b) by omitting from subsection (2) the word "twenty-one" and substituting therefor the word "eighteen"; and

- (c) by omitting from that subsection the word "eighteen" and substituting therefor the word "seventeen".
- **9** Section one hundred and eighty-nine of the Code is amended Abduction of by omitting the word "eighteen" (wherever occurring) and substituting therefor, in each case, the word "seventeen".
- 10 Section one hundred and ninety of the Code is amended by Defences in omitting the word "eighteen" and substituting therefor the word girls. "seventeen".
- 11 Section three hundred and thirty-five of the Code is amended Rape. by omitting from paragraph (a) the word "eighteen" and substituting therefor the word "seventeen".
- **12** Section three hundred and thirty-six of the Code is amended Defilement by omitting the word "eighteen" and substituting therefor the word "seventeen".
- **13** Section three hundred and thirty-seven of the Code is amended Incest. by omitting from paragraph (a) the word "eighteen" and substituting therefor the word "seventeen".
- **14** Section four hundred and twenty-eight of the Code is Custody of young girls in certain cases.
 - (a) by omitting from subsection (1) the word "eighteen" and substituting therefor the word "seventeen"; and
 - (b) by omitting from that subsection the word "twenty-one" (wherever occurring) and substituting therefor, in each case, the word "eighteen".
