CRIMINAL CODE AMENDMENT (INDICTMENTS) ACT 1996

No. 5 of 1996

An Act to amend the Criminal Code in respect of indictments for murder

[Royal Assent 27 June 1996]

Be it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:

Short title

1. This Act may be cited as the Criminal Code Amendment (Indictments) Act 1996.

Commencement

2. This Act commences on the day on which it receives the Royal Assent.

Principal Act

3. In this Act, the *Criminal Code** is referred to as the Code.

Section 311 amended (Form and contents of indictments)

- 4. Section 311 of the Code is amended as follows:
 - (a) by omitting from subsection (2) "subsection (3) and";
 - (b) by omitting subsection (3).
