AN ACT to amend the *Criminal Code*

[Royal Assent 4 October 1989]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

Short title

1—This Act may be cited as the *Criminal Code Amendment (Financial Advantage) Act 1989*.

Commencement

2—This Act shall commence on the day on which it receives the Royal Assent.

Principal Act

3—In this Act, the *Criminal Code** is referred to as the Code.

Section 252A amended (Acquiring a financial advantage)

4—Section 252A (1) of the Code is amended by omitting “obtains” and “obtaining”, and substituting “acquires” and “acquiring” respectively.
