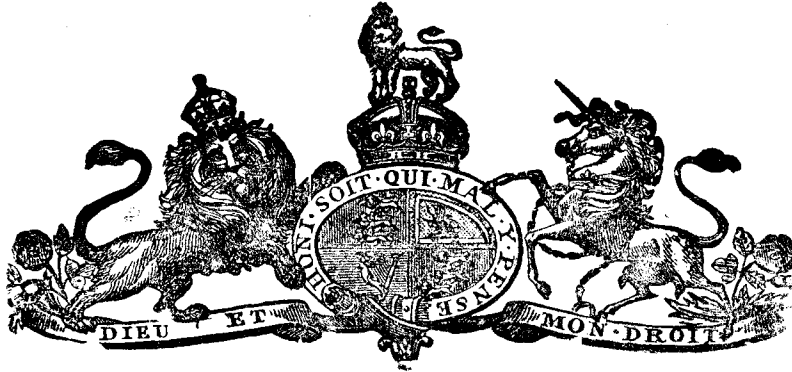

WHEREAS doubts have arisen as to the power of the Council of the Municipality of Circular Head to levy lighting rates on property outside the boundaries of the Town of Stanley: Preamble.
And whereas it is desired to exempt portions of properties outside the Towns of Smithton and Stanley from lighting rates:
And whereas doubts have arisen as to the validity of the proclamation repealing the *Stanley Lighting Act 1924* and its amendments:

Circular Head Lighting.

A.D. 1935.

Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

Short title.

1 This Act may be cited as the *Circular Head Lighting Act 1935*.

Repeal.

2 The Acts enumerated in the first schedule hereto are hereby repealed.

Light districts.

3 The areas in respect of which the Council of the Municipality of Circular Head may make and levy rates for the purposes of section seven of the *Local Authorities Lighting Act 1930* shall be as set out in the second schedule.

Proviso.

Provided always that in respect of any properties within the said areas, but completely outside the Towns of Smithton or Stanley respectively, such rates shall be levied only in respect of that portion of those properties used for residential or non-agricultural purposes, and the Council of the Municipality of Circular Head is hereby empowered and authorised to assess, in accordance with the *Annual Values Assessment Act 1911*, the portions of all properties completely outside either of the said towns respectively and within either of the said rating areas used for residential or non-agricultural purposes.

Increase of area.

4 Such areas or either of them may be increased in manner provided by section seven of the *Local Authorities Lighting Act 1930*.

Circular Head Lighting.

THE SECOND SCHEDULE.

A.D. 1935.

STANLEY LIGHTING AREA.

All that portion of the Municipality of Circular Head known as "The Peninsula" and being all that area to the north of a line running due east and west through the junction of the Old Main-road from Wynyard to Stanley with the Main-road from Stanley to Forest and Smithton.

SMITHTON LIGHTING AREA.

All that portion of the Municipality of Circular Head bounded as follows:—Starting at a point on the north-east corner of W. L. Ollington's 418a. 3r. 30p. thence by the western boundary of Deep Creek to the intersection of the Stanley-Smithton Main-road thence westerly by that road to the north-east corner of E. B. Fenton's 516a. 3r. 21p. thence southerly to the south-east corner of the said block thence westerly and southerly to the south-east corner of T. W. Marthick's 191a. 2r. 3p. thence westerly southerly and westerly to Duck River thence westerly along the southern boundary of P. Stearne's 25a. thence northerly and westerly along the southern boundary of W. C. Wells' 25a. 0r. 37p. thence southerly to the south-east corner of D. J. Murray's 49a. 3r. 14p. thence westerly to the south-west corner of the same block thence northerly to the south-east corner of C. Maluga's 30a. 0r. 12p. thence westerly southerly and westerly to the south-west corner of S. N. Burgess' block of 103a. 3r. 13p. thence northerly westerly and northerly to the north-east corner of W. Geale's 317a. 2r. 31p. thence westerly northerly and westerly to the south-west corner of B. Burnley's 140a. 2r. 7p. thence northerly easterly and northerly to the north-west corner of H. G. Padman's 100a. 2r. 4p. thence south-westerly to the south-east corner of the Closer Settlement Department's 49a. 1r. 9p. thence northerly to the south-west corner of J. S. Lee & Sons' lease of 664a. thence by the western boundary of the said lease to Duck Bay thence easterly by Duck Bay to the point of commencement.
