

certificates or reports signed by a legally-qualified medical practitioner, and has furnished the Secretary with such other evidence (if any) as to the incapacity of the employee, as the Secretary may require.

“(5) In this section—

‘prescribed sum’ means a sum equivalent to twenty-eight times the hourly rate of pay for casual wharf clerks prescribed in the relevant award;

‘relevant award’ means the award made under the *Conciliation and Arbitration Act 1904-1965* of the Commonwealth and known as the Clerks (Shipping) Award 1965 as in force for the time being and includes any award under that Act made in amendment of or in substitution for the first-mentioned award.”.

**3** Section ten of the Principal Act is amended by adding at the end thereof the following subsection:—

“(4) The foregoing provisions of this section apply to and in relation to an employee who died at any time on or after the twentieth day of July 1966 and before the date of commencement of this Act as if this Act had commenced on the day preceding that employee’s death.”.

Payment in lieu of long service leave on death of employee.

## CROWN LANDS (MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS) (No. 2).

### No. 57 of 1966.

AN ACT to provide for the sale or grant of certain lands of the Crown and for the vesting of certain other lands in the Crown and the disposal of those lands, and to provide for incidental and consequential matters. [12 December 1966.]

**B**E it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

**1**—(1) This Act may be cited as the *Crown Lands (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act (No. 2) 1966*.

Short title and incorporation.

(2) This Act is incorporated, and shall be read as one, with the *Crown Lands Act 1935* (in this Act referred to as the Principal Act).

Disposal of part of road at Ralphs Bay to *H. V. Calvert*.

**2**—(1) All public rights of passage over the land specified in the first schedule are extinguished and those lands revert to and revest in Her Majesty absolutely, freed and discharged from all estates and interest therein subsisting in any person.

(2) The Commissioner may, on such terms and conditions as may be determined by the Surveyor-General, sell by private contract to *Herbert Vere Calvert*, of South Arm in this State, the land referred to in subsection (1) of this section.

Sale of reclaimed land at Bellerive to *Mrs. K. L. Lewis*.

**3** The Commissioner may, on such terms and conditions as may be determined by the Surveyor-General, sell by private contract to *Kathleen Louise Lewis*, of Bellerive in this State, the land of the Crown specified in the second schedule.

Grants of land for certain old persons' homes.

**4** On payment in each case of a grant fee of six dollars, the Governor may, in the name and on behalf of Her Majesty, grant for an estate in fee simple—

- (a) the land of the Crown specified in the third schedule to the Huon Districts' Eldercare Home Association Inc.;
- (b) the land of the Crown specified in the fourth schedule to the Emmerton Park Homes Incorporated; and
- (c) the land of the Crown specified in the fifth schedule to the West Coast Home for the Aged Association Inc.

Transfer of land at Ulverstone to Roland View Trust Estate.

**5**—(1) The land specified in the sixth schedule reverts to and revests in Her Majesty absolutely, freed and discharged from all estates and interests therein subsisting in any person.

(2) On payment of a grant fee of six dollars, the Governor may, in the name and on behalf of Her Majesty, grant the land referred to in subsection (1) of this section to the trustees of the Roland View Trust Estate for an estate in fee simple.

Supplementary provisions.

**6**—(1) Where under this Act the Commissioner is empowered to sell any land of the Crown the Governor may, in the name and on behalf of Her Majesty, upon the payment or furnishing of the sum or other consideration required to be paid or furnished by this Act or the contract under which the land is sold, and upon the payment of any survey or grant fees so required to be paid before a grant of the land is made, grant the land to the person to whom it is by this Act authorized to be sold.

(2) Without prejudice to the generality of the provisions of this Act, where power is conferred by this Act on the Governor to grant any land of the Crown that power may be exercised notwithstanding any rights or claims otherwise exercisable in relation thereto under the *Lands Resumption Act 1957* or any Act repealed by that Act.

(Section 3.)

All that area of land containing 19 7/10p. situate in the Town of Bellerive and being the land indicated on Survey Plan 1702 filed and registered in the office of the Surveyor-General and Secretary for Lands at Hobart in Tasmania.

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### THE THIRD SCHEDULE.

(Section 4 (a).)

All that area of land containing 3r. 28 7/10p. situate in the Town of Franklin and being the land indicated on Survey Plan 1642 filed and registered in the office of the Surveyor-General and Secretary for Lands at Hobart in Tasmania.

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### THE FOURTH SCHEDULE.

(Section 4 (b).)

All that area of land containing 7a. 2r. 11 9/10p. situate in the Town of Smithton and being the land indicated on Survey Plan 1825 filed and registered in the office of the Surveyor-General and Secretary for Lands at Hobart in Tasmania.

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### THE FIFTH SCHEDULE.

(Section 4 (c).)

All that area of land containing 1a. 0r. 0 2/10p. situate in the Town of Strahan and being the land indicated on Survey Plan 1826 filed and registered in the office of the Surveyor-General and Secretary for Lands at Hobart in Tasmania.

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### THE SIXTH SCHEDULE.

(Section 5.)

All that area of land containing 1r. 12 8/10p. situate in the Town of Ulverstone and being the land contained in the Certificate of Title in Volume 262, Folio 56, of the Register Book kept under the *Real Property Act 1862*.
