CONSOLIDATED REVENUE DEFICIT (FUNDING) (No. 2).

No. 70 of 1951.

AN ACT to authorise the Funding of the Deficit in the Consolidated Revenue Fund for the financial year ended the thirtieth day of June, 1950. [21 November, 1951.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:--

Short title.

1 This Bill may be cited as the Consolidated Revenue Deficit (Funding) Act (No. 2) 1951.

Power to borrow £141.390 11s. 2d. to fund deficit for 1949-50.

2 The Treasurer may borrow any sums of money, not exceeding £141,390 11s. 2d., for the purpose of funding the deficit in the Consolidated Revenue for the financial year ended on the thirtieth day of June, 1950.

PUBLIC WORKS EXECUTION (No. 3). No. 71 of 1951.

AN ACT to provide for the execution and carrying out of certain Public Works and Purposes, and to authorise the borrowing of certain sums of money, and the reappropriation of certain unexpended moneys, for meeting the cost of those Works and Purposes, and for the purposes of the Transport Act 1938, and Hydro-Electric Commission Act 1944.

1 This Act may be cited as the Public Works Execution Act (No. 3) 1951.
