

EDUCATION.

No. 19 of 1960.

AN ACT to amend the *Education Act 1932*. [20 June 1960.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1—(1) This Act may be cited as the *Education Act 1960*. Short title and citation.

(2) The *Education Act 1932*, as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

2 Section seven of the Principal Act is amended— Fees.

(a) by omitting from subsection (1) the word “No” and substituting therefor the words “Subject to this section, no”; and

(b) by adding at the end the following subsection:—
“(2) In State schools that are tertiary technical schools, such fees as may be prescribed may be charged in such cases as may be prescribed.”.

3 Section forty-seven of the Principal Act is amended by Regulations. adding at the end thereof the following subsection:—

“(7) The regulations may—

(a) provide for and regulate the arrangement and conduct of expeditions, excursions, and other journeys for pupils attending State schools;

(b) require the parents, guardians, or other persons having the custody of any child attending a State school to enter into an agreement indemnifying the Crown and all or any specified officers (including teachers) of the Department against any action, claim, or demand arising or likely to arise by reason of the death of, or any injury to, any child who proceeds on any such expedition, excursion, or journey; and

(c) prohibit all or any specified teachers or class of teachers from permitting any child attending a State school to proceed on any such expedition, excursion, or journey unless the parents, guardians, or other persons having the custody of the child have first entered into such an agreement.”.
