### ANALYSIS

**AN ACT to make provision for certain matters arising out of a teacher being appointed full time president of the Tasmanian Teachers Federation.**  
**[16 May 1974]**

**BE** it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

**1—(1)** This Act may be cited as the *Education (Teachers Federation) Act 1974*. Short title and citation.

**(2)** This Act is incorporated, and shall be read as one, with the *Education Act 1932* (in this Act referred to as the Principal Act).

Leave of absence on account of presidency of Federation.

**2** Notwithstanding anything contained in the Principal Act, the Director-General shall grant leave of absence without pay to a teacher for any period during which he holds the office of president of the Tasmanian Teachers Federation (being a body incorporated under the *Companies Act 1962*) and devotes his full time to that office.

Supplementary provisions.

**3**—(1) Notwithstanding anything in the *State Employees (Long-Service Leave) Act 1950* any period of leave of absence granted to a teacher under section 2 shall for all the purposes of that Act be regarded as a period of his service as an officer of the Teaching Service.

(2) For the purposes of the provisions of the Principal Act and the regulations made thereunder so far as they relate to the entitlement of an officer to leave of absence in the case of sickness a period of leave of absence granted under section 2 shall be regarded as a period of service as a teacher.

Past president not to be disadvantaged on return to service as a teacher.

**4** A teacher who, on the termination of a period of leave of absence granted under section 2, returns to service as an officer of the Teaching Service, shall be paid a salary and allowances no less than he would have then been receiving had he continued in the same office or position as that held by him immediately before the commencement of that period of leave of absence.
